Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill classifies nurses and physician assistants employed at state correctional institutions or secured correctional facilities as protective occupation participants for the purpose of the Wisconsin Retirement System.

The Department currently has 222 FTE that fall under Physician Assistant or "nurse" categories. Included in these classifications are Physician Assistants, Nurse Clinicians, Nursing Supervisors, Nursing Specialists, Nursing Consultants, Nurse Practitioners and Licensed Practical Nurses. The annual salary for these positions is \$9,457,300 with fringe benefits of an additional \$3,613,800. If these occupations are classified as protective, it will increase fringe benefit costs by approximately 8.6%. The additional cost would be approximately \$310,400 annually. These costs are based on December 2001 data.
