Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Because this bill would create a new criminal statute, it is likely to result in increased costs for the State Public Defender (SPD). The extent of the costs would depend on how many cases that are not currently prosecuted as criminal theft would be pursued criminally as a result of this legislation. These cases may involve issues of who actually took the cart and/or whether the defendant intended to return it.

County costs could increase for incarceration (pretrial or after disposition).
