Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill, if passed, would not have a fiscal effect on the Public Service Commission.

The bill prohibits the PSC from issuing a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN)until the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has completed work on it's permits including a new requirement under the bill to consider the effects of the electric generating facilities on residential wells. The bill further requires those utilities who have been issued a CPCN from the Commission before the effective date of this bill to file a supplemental engineering plan with the DNR.
