Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Statutes would need to be revised which is estimated at 100 hours at \$40 per hour (\$4,000). Certificates would be reissued for approximately 125 professionals at a cost of \$20 per license (\$2,500). As a result of the change it is estimated that there would be an increase in enforcement costs of about \$2,000. It is assumed that these would be one-time, first year costs and that there would be no long-term fiscal impact.
