Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill modifies the elements of the crime of stalking and establishes a new penalty structure. The present penalty is increased from a misdemeanor to a felony.

Because additional crimes will be brought into the circuit court under this new definition of stalking and felonies require more court time than misdemeanors, an increase in workload for the circuit courts is expected under this bill. The added workload would require judge, court reporter, court staff and possible juror time. By what amount is impossible to predict with the data available. These costs are borne by both the state and the county.
