Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would not affect the current restrictions on semitrailer or trailer length, but would affect the overall length limitation that applies only on those highways under state jurisdiction not designated under 348.07(4)

Given that trailer lenghts restrictions will remain on those non-designated routes, the operational characteristics of these vehicles are not expected to change signficantly by allowing the increased overall lenght.

Fiscal impacts are not expected to be significant and consist of modifying training information for enforcement personnel and other departmental materials and guidance. The change may tend to limit some presure for additional route designations on the state system, but would not be expected to provide significant cost savings.

The change may affect a very small or inconsequential change in citations for overlength vehicles. The fiscal impact of that change is not expected to be significant.
