5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

Both the department's analysis and the text of the rule refer to "supervised" experience in architectural work. Section 443.03 (1) (b), Stats., does not refer to "supervised" experience and the only reference to "supervised" experience in s. A-E 3.03 is found in sub. (2) of that section. Consequently, is reference to "supervised" experience in architectural work under this section too limiting or a possible source of confusion?

PROPOSED ORDER

An order of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors to create A-E 3.03 (5), relating to architectural interns.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b) and 227.11 (2), Wis. Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 443.03, Wis. Stats.

The Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors proposes to create s. A-E 3.03 (5) to permit the use of an architect-related title prior to formal licensure. This rule will allow a person in the process of acquiring supervised experience as an architect to use the title "architectural intern." The proposed rule will not modify the registration requirements for architects, but will permit use of the term "architectural intern" while a potential licensee is in the process of gaining the required experience.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. A-E 3.03 (5) is created to read:

A-E 3.03 (5) An individual acquiring supervised experience in architectural work under this section for the purpose of satisfying the requirements of s. 443.03 (1) (b), Stats., may use the title "architectural intern."

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Wis. Stats.
