**SENATOR CAROL ROESSLER'S TESTIMONY ON SB 371**

SENATE BILL 371 ADDRESSES THE INVASION OF PRIVACY BY PROVIDING PROPER PENALTIES AND NEEDED REHABILITATION.

TODAY, I BRING THIS LEGISLATION BEFORE YOUR COMMITTEE BECAUSE OF AN OSHKOSH MAN NAMED KENNETH CULVER WHO HAS A PROBLEM WITH WINDOW PEEPING. SINCE 1990, MR. CULVER HAS BEEN CHARGED WITH OVER 46 VARIOUS OFFENSES. HE WAS OFTEN CAUGHT OBSERVING WOMEN UNDRESSING AND SHOWERING. ALTHOUGH HIS VICTIMS ARE TOO NUMEROUS TO MENTION, TODAY YOU WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO LISTEN TO ONE OF HIS VICTIMS, DEBRA KRAMER. I APPLAUD DEBRA'S COURAGE AND PERSONALLY THANK HER FOR ATTENDING TODAY'S HEARING.



## **SENATOR CAROL ROSTER'S TESTIMONY ON SB371**

UNFORTUNATELY, UNDER CURRENT LAW, THERE IS NO PROVISION TO CHARGE A PERSON WITH A CRIME WHO LOOKS INTO THE DWELLING OF ANOTHER PERSON FOR THE PURPOSE OF SEXUAL GRATIFICATION. OFFICERS SOMETIMES CHARGE A PERSON WITH DISORDERLY CONDUCT OR LEWD BEHAVIOR, BUT NOTHING PERTAINING SPECIFICALLY TO A SEX CRIME.

MR. CULVER WAS CHARGED WITH DISORDERLY CONDUCT. THE RESULT...NO TREATMENT WAS EVER ADMINISTERED. THE PROBLEM...KENNETH CULVER WANTED TREATMENT BUT GOT A SLAP ON THE WRIST AND NO TREATMENT.

WORKING WITH LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENTS LIKE CHERYL JOHNSON AND JOHN MANION WHO ARE ALSO HERE TODAY; REPRESENTATIVE LEE MEYERHOFER AND I DRAFTED THIS PROPOSED LEGISLATION TO ADDRESS THIS PROBLEM.

## **SENATOR CAROL ROSTER'S TESTIMONY ON SB 371**

AS YOU ALL WELL KNOW, MANY TIMES AN INDIVIDUAL STARTS OFF PEEPING AND OVER TIME THEIR PEEPING TURNS INTO STALKING, AND ESCALATES INTO MORE VIOLENT BEHAVIOR LIKE RAPE.

WHAT SENATE BILL 371 SPECIFICALLY DOES?

- RECOGNIZES PEEPING AS A "SEX CRIME"
- PROVIDES PROPER REHABILITATION TO PERPETRATORS
- ALLOW JUDICIAL DISCRETION AS TO WHETHER AN INDIVIDUAL IS PLACE ON THE SEX OFFENDERS LIST
- ORDERS THE COURT TO EXPUNGE A JUVENILE'S DELINQUENCY IF THEY COMPLETE THE PROPER TREATMENT
- AS YOU WELL KNOW, A FEW YEARS AGO, WE PASTED LEGISLATION THAT STATED THAT NO PERSON COULD KNOWINGLY INSTALL A SURVEILLANCE DEVICE TO OBSERVE A PERSON. THE PUNISHMENT FOR THIS CRIME WAS NO MORE THAN \$10,000 OR IMPRISONMENT OF NINE MONTH. THIS LEGISLATION BEFORE YOU TODAY HAS THE SAME PENALTIES.

**SENATOR CAROL ROSTER'S TESTIMONY ON SB 371**

TODAY, KENNETH CULVER SHOULD BE IN TREATMENT  
REHABILITATING FOR HIS BEHAVIOR BUT  
UNFORTUNATELY THAT WILL NOT HAPPEN UNTIL WE  
RECOGNIZE THIS AS A SERIOUS CRIME AND CHANGE  
THE LAW.
