## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill requires a library that is supported by public funds, upon the request of a parent or guardian of a child under the age of 16, to disclose to the parent or guardian all library records relating to the use of the library's documents or other materials, resources, or services by the child.

It is assumed that public libraries would incur increased costs related to staff time in producing records of a child's library use for a parent or guardian who makes such a request. Because it is unknown how many such requests will be made, or how extensive these records may be, these costs are indeterminate.

This bill has no state fiscal effect.
