Re: SB 75 Exemption from civil liability for issuance of fireworks permits
Date: June 10, 2003

On behalf of Wisconsin Towns Association we wish to express our support for SB 75 which creates an exemption from civil liability for local officials who issue fireworks permits in accordance with Sec. 167.10 (3) and (5) of Wis. Statutes. This civil exemption is modeled after the same type of civil exemption for local officials and governments in the issuance of alcohol licenses under Sec. 125.037 of Wis. Statutes.

Our Association requested the Special Study Committee on Review of Fireworks Law to consider placing this type of civil exemption in the statutes to protect local officials from claims for merely issuing fireworks permits under Sec. 167.10 of Wis. Statutes. SB 75 will codify this principle.

We ask the committee to recommend passage of this bill. Thank you for your consideration.
