Right to a jury trial for juvenile who may be placed in secure custody beyond age of majority									

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would allow a juvenile, his or her parents, guardian, or legal custodian the right to a trial by jury if the person filing the delinquency petition reserves the right to recommend placement of the juvenile in the Serious Juvenile Offender Program or in a secured correctional facility beyond the age of 17.

This bill should have no fiscal impact on county detention facilities or the Department of Corrections, since the placement a juvenile is given is not dependent on whether a judge or a jury determines the juvenile's disposition.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
