## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This fiscal estimate is limited to potential fiscal impacts of the bill on the Legislative Fiscal Bureau. The bill would require that the Bureau prepare, for each version of the biennial budget bill or bills adopted by the Legislature, an identification of recommendations in those bills that may have a significant impact on the general fund balance as reported under the GAAP accounting basis that is shown in the state's comprehensive annual fiscal report (CAFR). While this requirement would add to the Bureau's workload during the biennial budget process, it is assumed that the additional workload could be accomplished without the need for any additional staff.
