Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a local government responsible for issuing building permits (generally a town, village, city, or county) may require a property owner to obtain a plumbing permit and pay a fee before plumbing fixtures are added or replaced in an existing structure or building. Under the bill, no town, village, city, or county could impose a new fee for this purpose, and existing fees for this purpose could not be enforced.

Based on fee schedules from some of the state's larger cities, the permit fee for adding or replacing plumbing fixtures in an existing structure or building ranges from \$5 to \$10 per fixture. Data from these cities' financial report forms do not separate these plumbing permit fees from other plumbing permit fees (such as those for new construction, storm sewers, and sanitary sewer connections). The Department of Revenue is therefore unable to reasonably estimate the revenue loss for local governments this bill could engender.
