Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a new misdemeanor that prohibits a person from intentionally preventing or attempting to prevent another from making a telephone call to the number "911" to report an emergency. Violations of this prohibition are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor for which the person may be fined not more than \$1,000 or confined in jail for not more than 90 days or both.

It is unknown how many cases will be subject to the terms of this bill. Additional proceedings require additional judge, court reporter, court staff and juror time. These costs are borne by both the state and the county. An accurate estimate of the additional costs is impossible with the data available, but it is likely to have a minor impact on the overall workload of the circuit courts.
