## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

If enacted, this bill may increase the number of cases referred to District Attorneys' Offices by law enforcement. This will increase the workload of the county employed support staff of the DA office as well as increasing the usage of county paid supplies and services of the DA office. There are no data by which to estimate the number of new cases that otherwise would not have been referred to DA offices would were this bill to be enacted, but the number of cases where the only crime charged would be the one created by this bill is likely to be small.
