## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law classifies police officers, fire fighters and other individuals whose jobs involve a high degree of danger and physical conditioning as protective occupation participants. This bill classifies food services workers employed at state correctional facilities, secured correctional facilities, Mendota Mental Health Institute, Winnebago Mental Health Institute, the Wisconsin Resource Center and a secure mental health unit or facility for sexually violent persons as protective occupation participants for the purpose of the Wisconsin Retirement System.

Under this bill, 67.0 FTE will be reclassified from unprotective to protective occupation status. In DHFS, the fringe rate for positions classified as protective occupation positions is 5.10% higher than the fringe rate for other positions because they qualify for more generous retirement benefits. The protective fringe rate is 49.32% compared to 44.22% for unprotective classifications. Under this bill, fringe costs for DHFS staff will increase by \$67,600 GPR and \$20,200 PR for a total increase of \$87,800 annually.
