Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, the Department is required to regulate restaurants, as defined in statute. There are exceptions to this regulation, including meals sold by churches and other organizations, school lunchrooms, public farm stands, and vending machines. This bill adds potluck meals, as defined in the bill, to the list of exceptions to restaurant regulation.

The Department and local health departments do not currently license or regulate potlucks, so this bill will have no fiscal impact on the Department or local units of government.
