Temporary reduction in motor vehicle fuel tax rate								

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill reduces the rate of the motor vehicle fuel tax by 15 cents per gallon for the 120 day period beginning on the fourteenth day after the bill's effective date.

In fiscal year 2005-06 the bill also transfers from the general fund to the transportation fund an amount determined by the department of revenue that is approximately equal to the difference between the amount of taxes that the Department collected during the 120 day period and the amount of taxes that the department would have collected if the reduction had not been in effect.

The Department of Transportation estimates that the bill would decrease motor fuel tax revenue collections by \$157.5 million. Consequently, the bill's requirement that a transfer be made from the general fund to the transportation fund to offset the loss of SEG motor fuel tax revenue created by the bill will reduce the general fund's balance by \$157.5 million.

The Department of Revenue's costs to administer the bill would be absorbed in its budget.
