Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill directs the Department of Administration (DOA) to annually publish and distribute a telephone directory of state officers and employees.

Prior to 2001, the state published a telephone directory including name, address, agency, and e-mail address for state employees (excluding the UW). It also included a separate listing of all agencies and subunits within those agencies. Beginning in 2001, the directory was switched to a web-accessible format and the hardcopy discontinued. This estimate assumes that the format used prior to 2001 meets the requirements of this bill. The total annual cost to publish this directory is \$213,000 including:

\$150,000 - Cost to print 40,000 copies

\$25,000 - LTEs to assist in proofing

\$28,000 - Department (DOA) staff to maintain the database and coordinate production

\$10,000 - Agency staff to verify and update information on agency structure

The bill directs that distribution of this directory to be at no cost to the officers and employees of the state. However, the unit responsible for managing the state telephone network is program revenue funded. Consequently, the Department might need to increase state phone rates or charge agencies based on the number of employees listed in the directory.
