Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

If this bill were enacted, it is difficult to predict the number of new cases that would be generated statewide as a result of adding another category of criminal offense under this statute. If crimes occur that are covered by this new provision it could impact on the district attorney workload in one or more counties within the state. However, the significance of enacting this change on workload cannot be reasonably estimated at this time because the number of specific charges brought under the new citation cannot be predicted. If the bill is enacted, data could be collected for a future estimate of financial impact.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Uncertain
