Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

- * SB 423 does not require DWD to make any changes to its current child care provider processes nor the development of any administrative rules. Thus, there are no estiamted cost.
- *Found cases typically involve a situation where there is harm to a child from being left in the vehicle used to transport children to and from child care.
- *There is no basis for determing the number of found cases annually of chidren being left unattended in a vehicle although newspaper reports would indicate that they are very few in number annually.
- *Counties would be required to consider submitting such found cases for prosecution.
- *There is no basis for estimating the county child care certifying agency cost of referring a case for prosecution and providing documentation to the prosecuting agency of the vehicle driver being in violation of this bill.
