Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

There are no data by which to estimate the number of actions for injunctions that DA offices will bring annually against product manufacturers were this bill to be enacted. However, given that DATCP, DOJ and others may also do this, it is unlikely that there will be many instances of DA offices taking this action.
