Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

If enacted this bill would require town boards to confirm appointments to a town plan commission. Currently, the town board chair makes the appointments.

Since this confirmation process would probably be added to the agenda of an already scheduled meeting, this bill would have minimal direct fiscal impact. However, this additional step could delay the planning process if the chair and a majority of the board cannot agree on suitable members.
