This bill would add real looking but fake firearms to the statute that prohibits the intentional pointing of real firearms at a law enforcement officer in the course of his or her duty. This bill has the potential to result in numerous additional cases being referred to district attorneys offices by law enforcement but no data exist by which to make an accurate estimate of that number.
