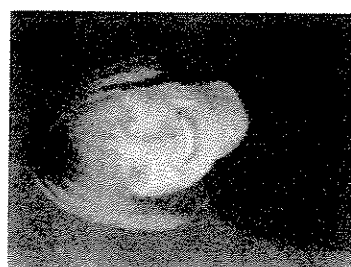
## 2004 Outstanding Art Educator of the Year, Lola Kennedy

Lola Kennedy is an art teacher working at 68th Street Early Childhood Center, Milwaukee Public Schools, who has pioneered use of Reggio Emilia learning in two of Milwaukee's early childhood facilities. As a recognized expert in early childhood education, Lola has presented workshops and breakout sessions at WAEA conferences, NAEA conventions and WAAE Summits. She has been a member of the WAEA Board and served as publicity and regional Youth Art Month Chairperson. She was a member of an art audit team for Kenosha and wrote, revised and edited an early childhood arts curricular guide for the MPS district. Lola planned many elementary art in-services in her district. Lola developed interactive art tours appropriate for early childhood students.



## Jessica Doyle, First Lady of the State of Wisconsin

"When you learn, teach; when you get, give." This quote by Maya Angelou is among Jessica Doyle's very favorites. A student, teacher, and educator Mrs. Doyle puts education first. Prior to serving as First Lady, Jessica was most recently a learning coordinator at Cherokee Middle School. Before that she worked at three other middle schools in Madison. For the past year and a half, the First Lady has been visiting schools across Wisconsin. She has had the opportunity to visit hundreds of excellent students and teachers across the state. Great learning experiences are happening in our schools everyday, and it's exciting to see them in action. School and family have always been Jessica's priorities. Supporting her family has come naturally for her throughout her thirty-six years of marriage. She is proud of her two wonderful sons, both in their twenties. The Doyles lived in Arizona from 1972-1975 where Jessica taught school. Before that, Jessica taught school in Acton, Massachusetts. In 1967-1969, Jessica and Jim served in the Peace Corps. They had just graduated from UW-Madison and were sent to Tunisia in North Africa where they served as English teachers. This experience, perhaps more than any other in their lives, instilled in them a spirit of service. The Peace Corps served to rededicate both of them to trying to make a difference for others.
