Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SUMMARY: This bill prohibits an applicant's social security number (SSN) from being used for the purpose of identifying the applicant on any examination for a position in the state civil service system. The bill also prohibits a seller of goods at retail from requesting that a customer disclose his or her SSN unless the seller is required to do so in issuing fish and game approvals as an agent of the DNR. Under current law, the DNR is required to obtain the SSN from an applicant for a fish and game approval so that the state may determine whether the applicant is delinquent in the payment of certain state taxes or in the payment of child support or other court-ordered family support of birth expenses.

FISCAL EFFECT: No state or local fiscal effect is expected The bill will not change the Department's procedures regarding the obtaining of SSNs. Additionally, the examination forms that the Department uses for DNR positions in the state civil service system are standardized and provided through the Office of State Employment Relations (OSER) at the Department of Administration (DOA). Thus any potential fiscal effect on the DNR would be as a result of DOA charging the DNR a proportionate share of DOA's costs to revise, print, and distribute state civil service examination forms. However, the DNR is unaware of what DOA's costs would be to revise the forms and whether DOA would share those costs with other state agencies.
