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Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Initiate emergency rule making procedures concurrently with permanent rule making procedures for six boards/councils; Nursing, Chiropractic, Dental, Midwives, Massage Therapy and Body Worker, and Athletic Trainers.

Cost breakdown per board for each Division or Office in the Department:

Office of Legal Council:

80 Paralegal hours @ \$30 per hour = \$2,400

60 Attorney hours @ \$57 per hour = \$3,420

Division of Board Services:

60 Bureau Director hours @ \$44 per hour = \$2,640

Total per Board = \$8,460

Total cost for all boards (6) = \$50,760

Additional costs:

Division of Management Services:

6 IS Systems Development Services Specialist hours @ 43 per hour = \$260

One additional meeting for the Massage Therapy and Body Worker Council = \$1,000

Grand Total = \$52,020

*All hourly rate calculations include a fringe rate of 42.09%.
