Description Imposing fees for acquiring public park land, dedicating storm water treatment facilities to the public, changing the time relating to when impact fees must be paid and used, and regulating the costs of certain professional services provided through a political subdivision		

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Summary: Under current law, municipalities (i.e., cities and villages) accept the ownership, and thus the long-term maintenance cost of storm water treatment facilities in a subdivision if a developer identifies on the plans that the facilities are areas dedicated to the public and the municipality approves the plat as such. The principal storm water treatment facilities that serve more than one property include detention ponds and infiltration basins.

This bill places conditions on the acceptance of storm water treatment facilities by requiring at least 80% of the lots in the subdivision to be sold and requiring a professional engineer to certify that the facility is in good condition before such acceptance can take place.

Fiscal Effect: The bill has no fiscal effect at the state or local level.
