<b>Description</b> Possession of certain nonnative wild animals of the family felidae and granting rule-making authority		

**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

2007 AB 342 relates to registration with the Department of Natural Resources of individuals owning/possessing nonnative large cats. The legislation requires the Department of Commerce to promulgate rules establishing minimum standards for the construction and inspection of enclosures in which a nonnative wild animal is kept for the purpose of protecting the nonnative wild animal, the public and wildlife.

The Department estimates that the rules required by 2007 AB 342 can be promulgated within current budgetary resources. In addition, the Department anticipates approximately 100 total enclosures from this legislation, and that the workload associated with the regulatory activity (e.g., inspections) of these enclosures can be absorbed within current budgetary resources. Therefore, the Department estimates no fiscal impact resulting from this legislation.

The Department anticipates no fiscal impact on local units of government.
