Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a loan program for University of Wisconsin-Madison School of Pharmacy students who agree to work in pharmacy professional shortage areas in the state. The loan program would be administered by the Higher Educational Aids Board.

This bill will not impact programs administered by the Department of Health and Family Services. An increase in the number of pharmacists in pharmacy shortage areas may make it more convenient for Medicaid or SeniorCare program participants to fill their prescriptions, but it is not expected to cause an increase in the number of prescriptions filled under those programs.
