## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under s.252.24 of the statutes, the Department is required to license and regulate body piercers. "Body piercing" is defined as any human body part of tissue, except the ear, and the Department is not required to license or regulate ear piercing facilities under s.252.24. Local public health departments are also not required to license or regulate these facilities. As a result, AB 453, which prohibits the piercing of a child's ear, will have no effect on the Department or local public health departments.
