#### **SUMMARY**

This proposal aims to achieve three changes to state law:

- -Restructuring the penalties for operating while suspended or revoked or without a license
- -Changes the mandatory requirement that courts and DOT impose a revocation on a fourth offense operating while suspended making it permissive
- -Makes changes to penalties for railroad crossing convictions

#### **ASSUMPTIONS**

DMV will have to update its withdrawal processing system to remove the mandatory revocation on fourth offense OWS. DMV customer contact staff will need to be briefed on the law changes so they can accurately assist customers trying to reinstate their licenses.

#### CONCLUSION

\$3400 one time costs for updating DMV systems to not process an automatic revocation when receiving a fourth offense operating while suspended conviction.
