Assignment of income and earnings to pay a municipal court judgment									

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill allows a municipal court the authority to order an assignment of income if a person fails to pay a judgment owed to the municipal court. The authority granted to a municipal court by this bill is identical to authority that already exists for the circuit court to order an assignment of income if a person has failed to pay a forfeiture or a judgment due that court.

This bill is likely to result in additional collections of judgments by municipal courts and therefore increased revenue to the corresponding municipality. It may also require additional resources for the municipal courts to administer the assignments of income.

This bill does not appear to have any significant impact on the circuit courts.
