## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

If enacted, this bill would allow counties to retain 20 percent of fines and forfeitures unrelated to transportation ordinance violations that are collected and 30 percent of those fines and forfeitures that were imposed at least 180 days before the effective date of the bill and collected within one year of that date.

This bill would have no effect on the Department of Administration as the monies received by the state from these fines and forfeitures are deposited into the School Fund.
