Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits the purchase of materials or services or the contracting of construction work unless the bidder appears on a list maintained by DOA that indicates all of the bidder's employees have been verified to be eligible for employment in the United States. Since the UW System's construction contracting authority over 40K is processed through the DOA, they are best suited to address these costs. Assuming that there is no dollar threshold on purchases, all UW System purchasing transactions will be impacted by this bill. In FY07 the UW System procured goods from over 75,000 vendors. This bill could substantially decrease the number of vendors available to the UW System if a business decides not to become certified. If competition is reduced it is likely costs will increase, however these costs cannot be estimated. Administrative costs will increase with this bill because of the additional processing required to verify eligible vendors. In FY07, the UW System conducted 1,119,000 individual purchasing transactions. Conservatively estimating that it would take 2 minutes to verify the vendor's status by internet, this translates to 37,300 additional hours of work for the UW System employees, equivalent to 18 additional FTEs. Based on the average salary for Procurement positions in October 2007, the 18 FTE would cost \$877,900 in salaries and \$354,400 in fringe benefits for a total fiscal impact of \$1,232,300.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

This process could significantly reduce the number of vendors with whom the UW System can conduct business. If competition is reduced, it is likely costs will increase.
