Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The proposed bill would add to current law the provision for spouses, unremarried surviving spouse and children of veterans if the veterans is a resident of this state and was a resident of this state for a least 15 continuous years before the student registers for full remission of fees at any University of Wisconsin System or technical college.

Under current law, as created by 2005 Wisconsin Act 25, the spouses, unremarried surviving spouses and children of eligible veterans are eligible for full remission of tuition at the University of Wisconsin System and at technical colleges, which the Department of Veterans Affairs verifies to the educational institution that the person is an eligible veteran. Therefore, the proposed bill will not have any fiscal effect on the department.
