Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill affects the payment of police officers' salary after discharge or suspension in first class cities and also changes the time period for the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners (the board) to hold a trial, if one is requested.

This bill does not make any change to the current law provisions for circuit court review of the board's decisions in these disciplinary proceedings. Therefore, it does not appear this bill will have any fiscal impact on the circuit courts.
