## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill allows digital reproductions of photographs, films, motion pictures, audio or videotapes to be used as evidence under certain circumstances. This bill also creates a Class A misdemeanor for persons who knowingly submit altered digital reproductions. Penalties include fines of up to \$10,000 and 9 months in jail, or both.

The Department can not predict the number of persons who will be convicted under the provisions of this bill. If a court places an offender on probation, it will increase the Department's costs by approximately \$2,600 annually, per person [FY09 costs].

Counties will incur increased costs if offenders are given a jail term.
