Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2009 AB 844 contains provisions regarding groundwater management to be administered by the Department of Natural Resourtces. 2009 AB 844 also contains a provision requiring the Department of Commerce to promulgate standards for the installation of graywater and rainwater systems, and for the use of graywater and rainwater.

The Department currently administers rules regarding the installation of plumbing fixtures and systems in the state, and related definition. Comm 81 contains related definitions and Comm 82.70 provides standards for individuals opting for the installation of systems to treat and reuse graywater and rainwater. Specifically, it contains the minimum requirements for the quality of the water and these requirements vary according to the what the water will be used for (e.g., drinking water, toilet flushing, surface irrigation, etc.). The Department also currently administers a process for the approval of systems to treat graywater and rainwater for reuse (over 60 such systems are currently approved). Also, the Department conducts plumbing plan review for the proposed installation of each approved system for the purpose of graywater and rainwater reuse.

Because there are currently rules and processes in place to accomplish the provisions of 2009 AB 844 that impact the Department, the Department estimates no additional, immediate workload associated with this proposed legislation and therefore no fiscal impact. An indeterminate workload is anticipated, resulting from this and other proposals' encouragement of water reuse technologies, which would increase the Department's plan review and inspection workload.

A workload for local units of government would result from the provisions of 2009 AB 844 that require local involvement in groundwater management activities. This workload is indeterminate.
