### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

If this bill is enacted, prosecutors anticipate a significant cost to DA offices. The number of petitions for injunction hearings or for injunctions granted by courts is difficult to determine; however, prosecutors estimate that a large number is issued each month. Many of the the injunctions would involve the surrender of firearms and would be contested by respondents. Because of the uncertainty regarding how many injunctions are granted, it is difficult to provide a fiscal estimate should this bill be enacted.

Prosecutors are concerned about the constitutionality of such a law.

Significant costs for Sheriff Departments and the Courts are anticipated.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Should this bill be enacted, prosecutors envision a significant long-range fiscal impact on their offices. Because the number of injunctions granted each month is difficult to determine, it is difficult to estimate the long-range cost of enactment of this bill.
