### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

#### BILL SUMMARY

The proposal requires DOT to enter in to an agreement with the Government Accountability Board (GAB) for the purpose of matching personally identifiable information on the official voter registration list maintained by the board.

The GAB shall maintain a system that instantly electronically verifies with DOT the validity of information provided by an elector when completing an application to register for voting purposes.

#### ASSUMPTIONS

DOT must enter in to an agreement with the GAB to electronically provide personally identifiable information about persons holding valid Wisconsin driver's licenses and identification cards. The information is to be provided for the purpose of facilitating the registration of eligible electors and to create a statewide registration list. The information shall include the person's full name and date of birth, their current address, and driver's license or identification card number.

The GAB shall maintain a system that instantly electronically verifies with DOT the validity of information provided by an elector when completing an application to register for voting purposes.

#### CONCLUSIONS

DOT computer system programming required to create the system to instantly verify the required personally identifiable information provided by an elector when completing an application to register for voting purposes will require an estimated 70 days of development time at a cost of approximately \$47,180.

Other than the cost of creating the computer systems, there should be minimal FTE or cost impact on DOT.

The fiscal impact on local governments is indeterminate.
