Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would transfer certain civil law or municipal ordinance violations committed by persons aged 17 to the jurisdiction of the juvenile court. It would also provide that juveniles who are adjudged to have committed a civil law or municipal ordinance violation could not be placed in a juvenile detention facility as a sanction.

It is impossible to predict how many such violations will be heard by the juvenile courts. Additional proceedings require additional judge, court reporter, and court staff time. These costs are borne by both the state and the county. An accurate estimate of the additional costs is impossible with the data available.

It is possible the provision preventing placement in a juvenile detention facility as a sanction would result in cost savings for counties. Counties typically bear the cost of providing juvenile detention facilities. An accurate estimate of the costs involved, and any possible savings, is impossible with existing data.
