
Senate Bill 430

December 16, 2009 Referred to Committee on Labor, Elections and Urban Affairs.

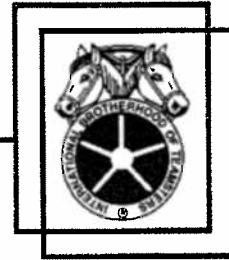
April 22, 2010 Failed to pass pursuant to Senate Joint Resolution 1.

This bill will prohibit bargaining over the selection of a health care coverage plan if the employer offers to enroll its employees in a plan provided to local government employers by the Group Insurance Board. The bill states that the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance must promulgate rules that set out standardized benefits under health care coverage plans that may be used for determining whether any health care coverage plan is similar to the plan offered by the Group Insurance Board. In addition the bill also allows for employers to unilaterally change employee's health care coverage plan provider if the benefits remain substantially the same or if cost savings will result.
