Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Currently, a school staff member may not have sexual contact or intercourse with a child who is over age 16, but under age 18, and enrolled in the person's school or school district. This bill makes it a crime for a person who is or was a school staff member to have sexual contact or intercourse with a person who is, or was within one year of the contact or intercourse, a student at a school where the person is or was a school staff member.

Should this bill be enacted, prosecutors do not anticipate a significant impact on their workload. Consequently, prosecutors do not expect any fiscal impact on their offices.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors do not expect a long-term fiscal impact on their offices if this bill is enacted.
