Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a person who is convicted of certain offenses is prohibited from receiving a license to operating a foster home and and is prohibited from licensure, certification and/or employment by a child care provider.

This bill makes it a crime for a person who is a member of a school staff to have sexual contact or sexual intercourse with a person who is, or was within one year of the contact or intercourse, a student at a school where the person is or was a member of the school staff. A conviction for this new offense would be added to the list of offenses for which a person would be permanently barred from obtaining a license to operate a foster home or operate or be employed by a child care facility.

This offense would be added to the list of offenses the Department checks for in its background check for foster homes and child care facilities. As a result, the bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact on the Department for licensing facilities or for counties performing child care certification activities.
