Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law prohibits school staff from having sexual contact or sexual intercourse with a child over 16 but less than 18 years old enrolled in the staff person's school or district and provides a penalty for guilty persons. Current law also includes restrictions on admissible evidence and trial spectators, and requires reporting of persons charged with this crime to the state.

This bill prohibits current or former school staff from having sexual contact or sexual intercourse with a student or person who was a student within a year of the contact or intercourse and provides the same penalties and restrictions of current law to guilty persons.

AB 243 is not expected to have a fiscal impact on the department or local health departments.
