### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill permits a juvenile court to transfer information relating to proceedings under the Children's Code or Juvenile Justice Code that is in the electronic records of the juvenile court to any other juvenile court, municipal court, court of criminal jurisdiction, or prosecutor. In addition, this bill allows the transfer of electronic information relating to the Juvenile Justice Code to a law enforcement agency.

Prosecutors do not anticipate any increase in workload as a result of this law, nor do they expect there to be any fiscal impact upon District Attorneys' offices.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors do not anticipate any long-term fiscal effect on their offices should this bill be enacted.
