## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Should this bill be enacted, prosecutors do not anticipate any fiscal impact on their offices because the burden to secure DNA samples is placed upon sheriffs' departments.

The bill requires sheriffs' departments to secure DNA samples as necessary, but the Department of Administration (DOA) does not have data concerning the cost of gathering these samples. Therefore, DOA's estimate of the local impact is indeterminate.

## **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

Prosecutors do not expect any long-term fiscal impact on their offices should this bill be enacted.
