Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

DSPS will need to update forms to gather information on whether applicants have veterans status. In addition, DSPS will need to implement a process to verify veterans status with the Department of Veterans Affairs. The cost is unknown. In addition, DSPS will need to coordinate and verify with other state agencies that in order to receive the exemption on the license fee, that such an exemption has not already been granted for another license. It will take staff time and associated costs to coordinate these efforts.

Revenues received for license fees will decrease for veterans granted the exemption. The amount of decreased revenue is unknown. It is unknown how many of DSPS license holders are veterans.
