2011 Assembly Bill 65

2011 Assembly Bill 65 requires that if a 1st class city imposes a residency requirement on police officers or fire fighters, it must allow residency to be within the county in which the 1st class city is located and within any county that is adjacent to the county in which the 1st class city is located.

<u>Assembly Amendment 1</u>

Assembly Amendment 1 to Assembly Bill 65 maintains the provisions of the bill, but moves the language from the general statute on residency for officials in a 1st class city to the specific statute governing police and fire departments in a 1st class city.

Legislative History

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Kuglitsch on April 26, 2011. On April 27, 2011, the Assembly Committee on Labor and Workforce Development recommended adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes, 9; Noes, 0.

On April 27, 2011, the Assembly Committee on Labor and Workforce Development recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 4.

Companion Bill

This bill contains the same provisions as 2011 Senate Bill 30, except for a proper cross-reference in this bill that is not corrected in Senate Bill 30. On March 22, 2011, the Senate Committee on Labor, Public Safety, and Urban Affairs held a public hearing on Senate Bill 30.

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
